

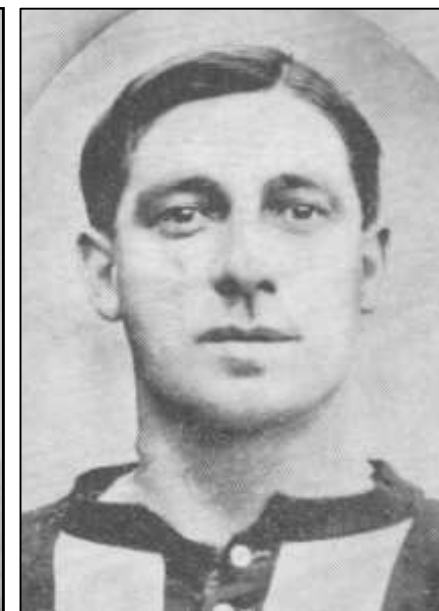

In his few Croydon Common appearances, he played in six positions; centre half, centre forward, right back, left back, right half and left half
Appeared for Croydon Common in 3 minor cup matches, without scoring
Scored a hat trick for Plymouth Argyle against his old club Reading (13.4.1912) and also one against Watford (16.12.1911)
Along with fellow Commoners Codling and Kingaby, he played in Clapton Orient's first ever Football League match (1-2 away to Leicester Fosse on 2.9.1905)
Was at Plymouth Argyle when the club won the Southern League championship in 1912-13 and was runner-up in 1911-12
Married Alice Cross and they had a son George and a daughter Alice
Towards the end of his life he was a process worker at a chemical works, while living at 6 Sydney Street in Northwich

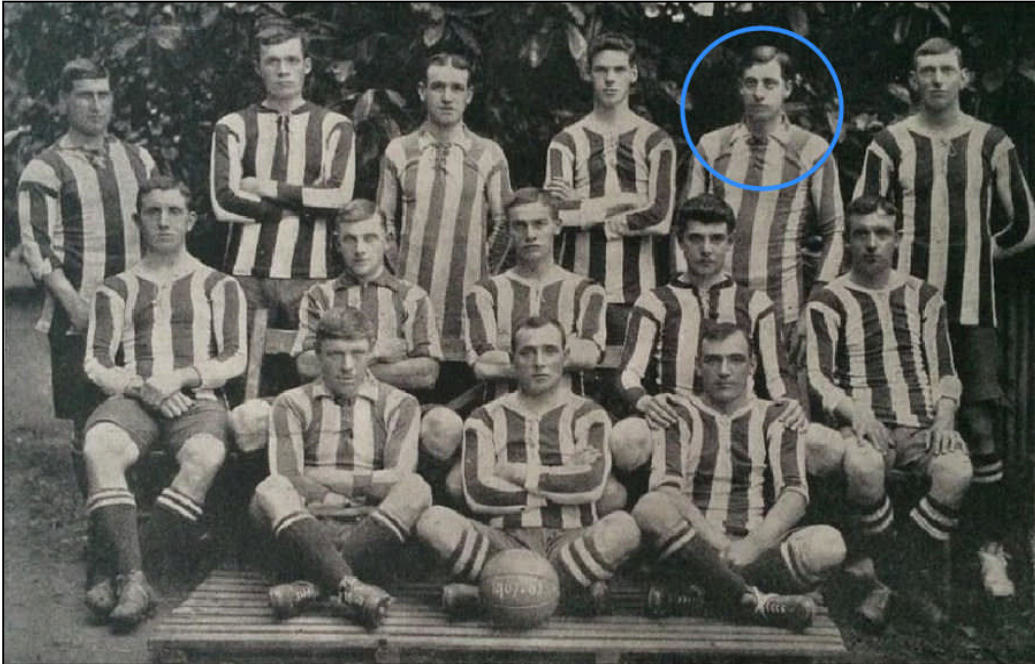

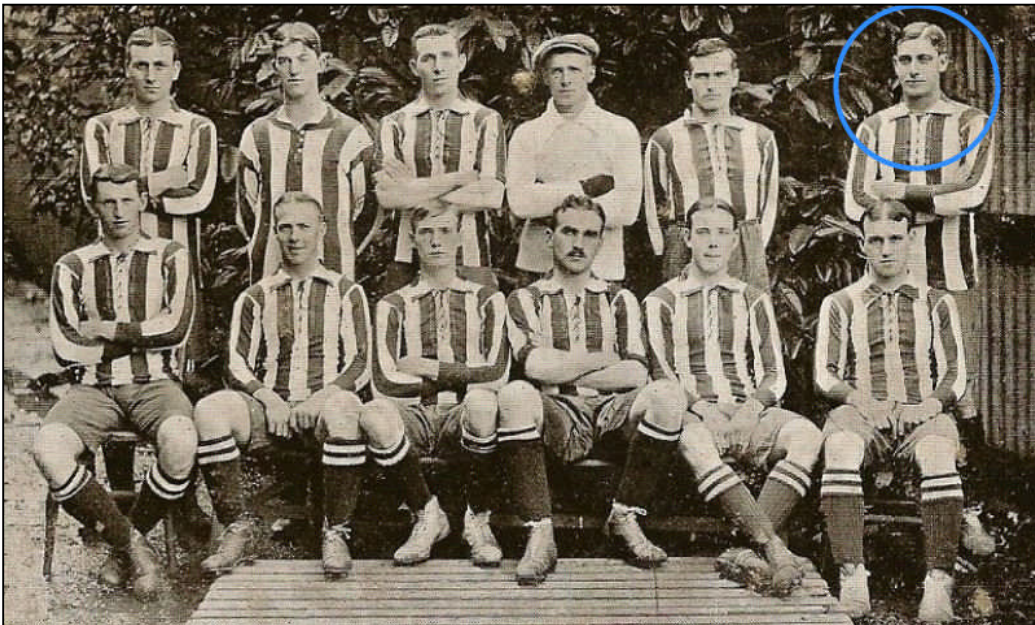
