Married Maud Waterworth on 21 July 1915 and had two sons, Douglas and Donald, and a daughter Pauline
Was a factory foreman at Eastman's Dye Works
The 1911 Census records him as a dry dyer living at 8 Ramsey Road, Acton with his parents, his younger brothers William, Albert and James and his older sister Emily
Was selected as centre half when a London Select team visited France to play two games; (i) v. a Paris Select eleven on 1.11.1913 (won 5-0) and (ii) v. Cercle Athletique de Paris on 2.11.1913
His descendants believe that he may have played for St. Johnstone, but this is as yet unconfirmed
