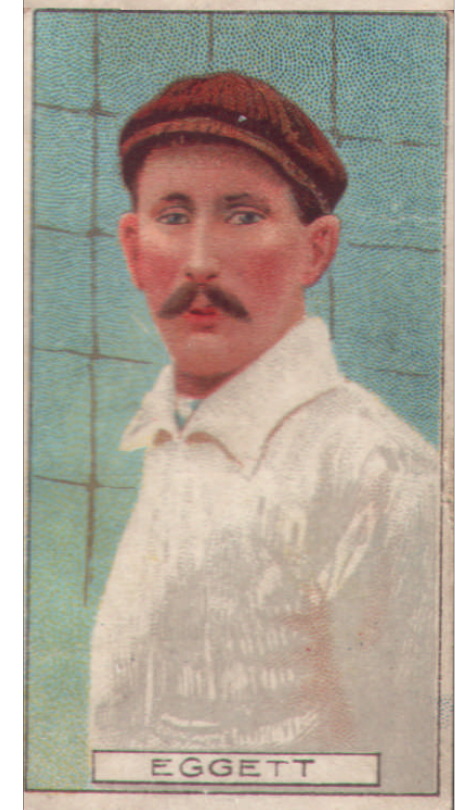

No first team appearances for Woolwich Arsenal or West Ham United
Played in Doncaster Rovers' first ever Football League match (3-3 at home to Burslem Port Vale on 7.9.1901)
In a FA Cup match against Rotherham Town in November 1895, which Doncaster Rovers lost 7-0, he was fouled by an opposing forward and, when he kicked him in retaliation, he was sent off and banned for six weeks
Played in the professional Croydon Common club's first competitive match
Played in Croydon Common's first F.A. Cup match
Played 14 other matches for Tottenham Hotspur
Played for Doncaster Wire Works for at least three seasons
The 1901 Census records him as a boilermaker's labourer living at 60 Spansyke Street, Doncaster with his wife Elizabeth (23) and daughters Rose (2) and Daisy (1)
The 1911 Census records him as a wire drawer living at 58 Spansyke Street, Doncaster with his parents in law, wife Elizabeth (33), daughters Rose (13), Daisy (11) and Elsie (7) and son John (9)

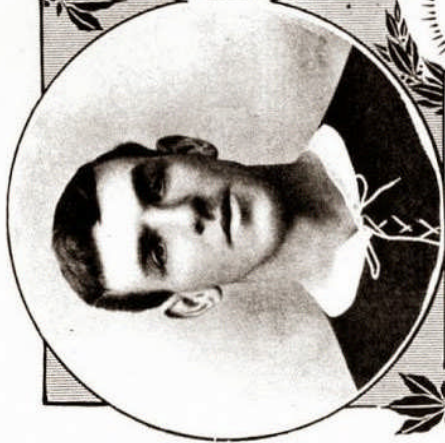

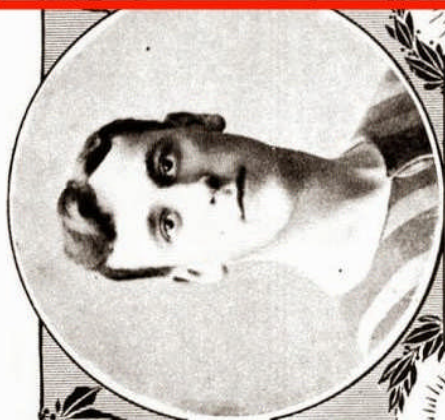
