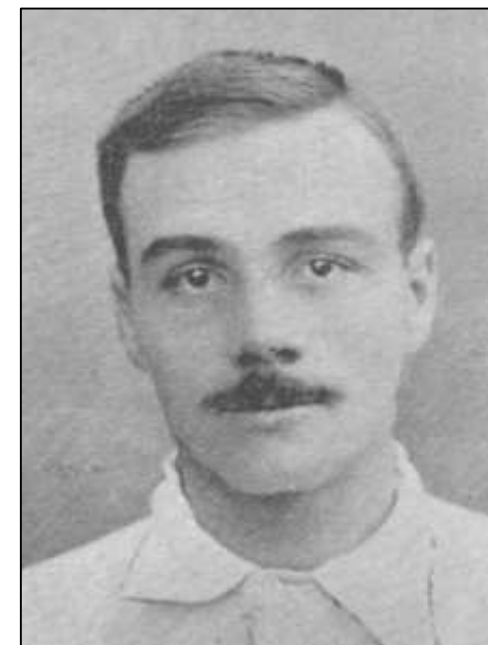

Recorded elsewhere as having been born in Dudley on 7 April 1882
Joined Halesowen as an amateur In 1905, but turned professional with the club two months later
Appears in some football records as James - perhaps the confusion was due to a James Gorman who played for Liverpool
Scored 2 goals on his debut for Wolverhampton Wanderers against Derby County on 21.4.1906
No first team appearances for Stoke
Appeared for Croydon Common in 2 minor cup matches, without scoring
Is recorded in the 1911 Census as a professional footballer and boarder at Cherry Street, Halesowen
Retired in 1914
Became a special constable with the Worcestershire Police in Halesowen in August 1914
<i>A dashing pivot with original methods in front of goal</i>
