Jottings

One of the players who played for both the amateur and the professional Croydon Common club, although he appears to have always been an amateur player

Played on numerous occasions for the professional club's reserve side

Represented the Croydon Charity League Select

He does not appear on the 1901 Census but, in the 1911 Census, he is recorded as a building surveyor's assistant, living at 71 Norbury Gardens, Melfort Road, Norbury, Croydon with his wife Violet (24?) and his children Florence (10), Elizabeth (8), Dorothy (5) and Cyril (2)

In October 1907, he appeared in court, charged with failing to comply with an order to make payments towards his mother's upkeep

During WW1, he was a Sergeant in the 17th Battalion of the Middlesex Regiment (Footballers' Battalion), with number G50722

Was a prisoner in the Schneidemuhl POW Camp in Poland, where he was stage manager of the camp theatre, and from where he was liberated at the end of the war

In 1926, he was recorded on his daughter's marriage certificate as a building inspector's assistant
