

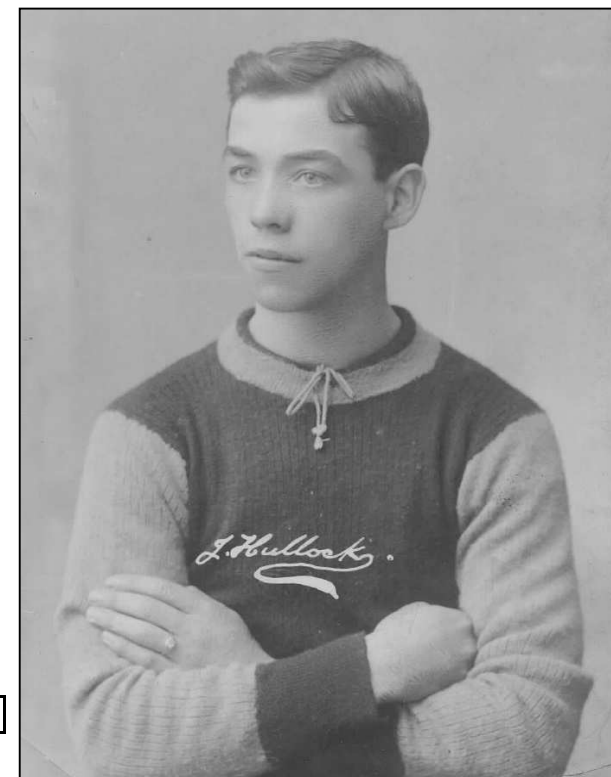

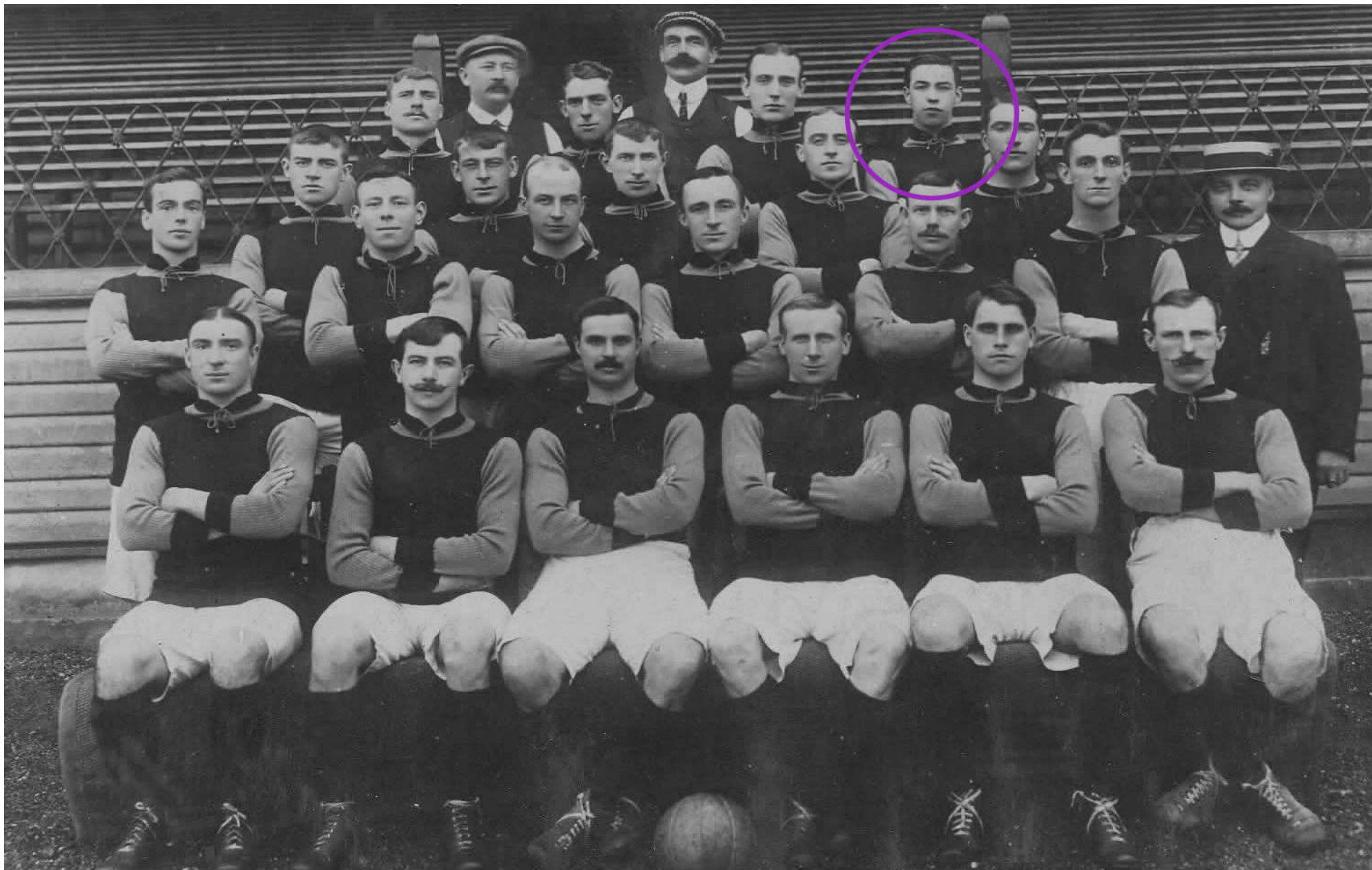

His name was occasionally spelt Hulloch
May have been in the Wallsend Park Villa side that shared the Tynemouth Cup with the Newcastle United A team after two drawn games (Year?)
No first team appearances for Fulham, where the handbook for the 1907-08 season records him as being a centre half
Played in Croydon Common's last ever match
The 1911 Census records him as a professional footballer living at 7 Greyflat Terrace, Carlisle
During the war he served with the King's Royal Rifle Corps and the Royal Engineers
Was living at 6 Dahomey Road in Streatham at the time of his death

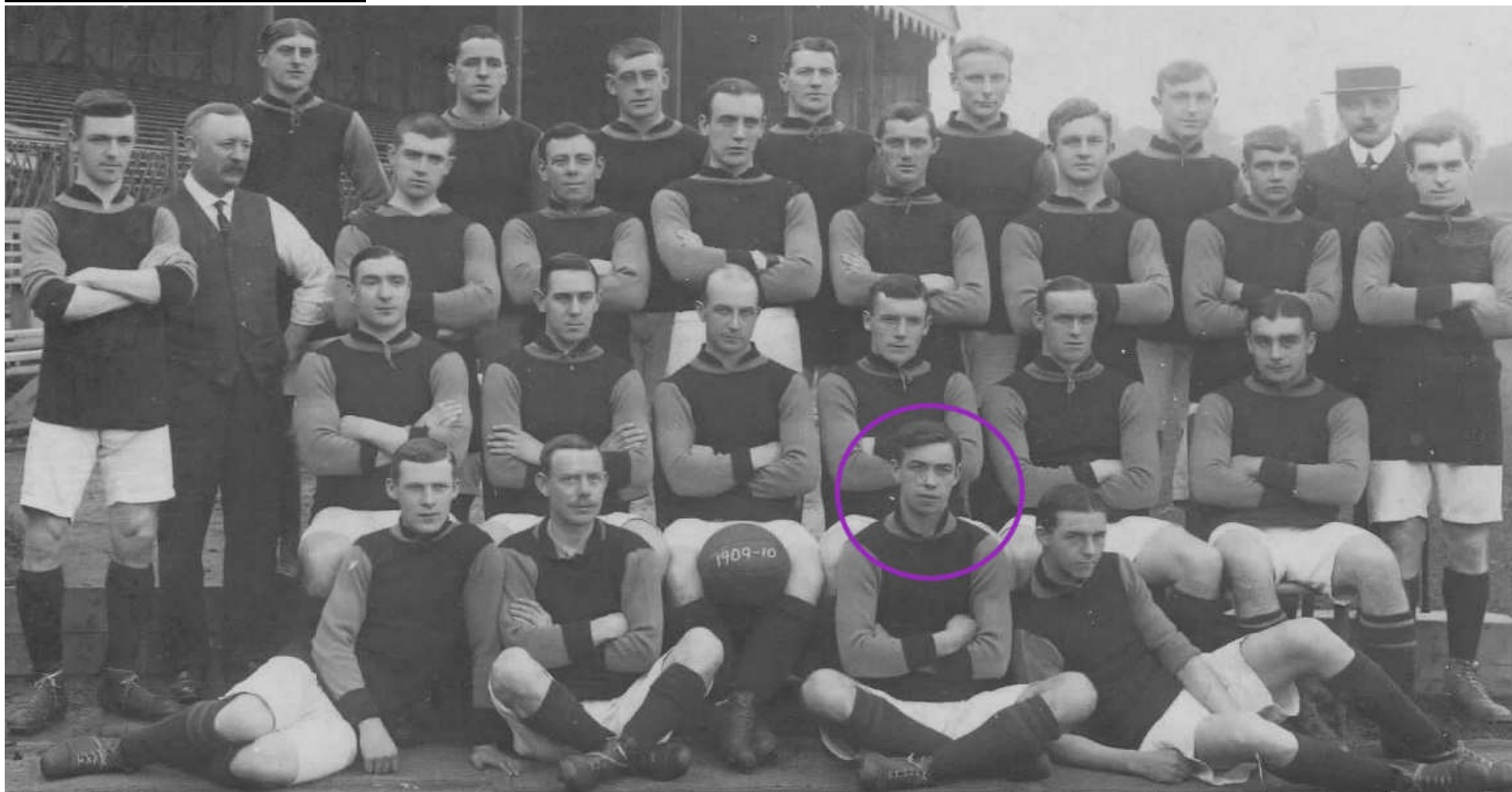


Crystal Palace 1908-09
