The above birth and death details are probable
His one appearance for Croydon Common was on the right wing in the 3-0 defeat at Newport County on Thursday 18 December 1913
His name was often misquoted in the press as Humphries
During the 1908-09 season, he played for Paddington Thursday during the week and for Bromley at the weekends
He was the top scorer for Bromley with 17 goals during the 1908-09 season, as the club won the Isthmian League
He appeared for Hampstead Town at least 21 times (13 goals) in 1912-13, when the club came second in Division 1 of the London League
He appeared for Hampstead Town at least 10 times (2 goals) in 1914-15
He scored against Croydon Common in a 1-0 win for Queens Park Rangers in the London Combination on Saturday 20.11.1915
He left Queens Park Rangers at the end of the 1915-16 season
