Was a painter and decorator by trade
Scored on his Croydon Common debut
Was awarded Norfolk County colours at 19
Appeared for Croydon Common in 2 minor cup matches, without scoring
Had a weakened heart, supposedly from catching at fever after swimming in the River Wensum in Norwich, and died following a short illness after catching a chill at just 48
In 1913-14, he also scored once in the Sheffield and Hallamshire F.A Senior Challenge Cup and twice in the Wharnccliffe Charity Cup
Was Doncaster Rovers top scorer in 1913-14 with 6 goals.
Is buried in Streatham Park Cemetery near Croydon
