<i>Jottings</i>

His name was usually reported in the Croydon press as Kearns
He played in one of the trial matches before the 1907-08 season and scored twice, but the press reported that he was with Eltham
A serious knee injury suffered while at Northfleet United meant that he was unable to play for two years
Was signed by Aston Villa on the recommendation of George Hunter who had earlier moved from Croydon Common to the club
Made no first team appearances for Aston Villa, but played for the club's reserve side
While he was at Aston Villa, he caused some confusion in the press as the club already had a long serving player named Jack Kearns
His only first team appearance for Birmingham was in a 2-2 draw at home to Gainsborough Trinity in the Second Division on 2.1.1909
His move to Birmingham was as a makeweight in a transfer deal
