Was trainer for Portsmouth, assistant trainer for Brighton & Hove Albion from 1905, trainer for Croydon Common from 1908 and for Southend United from 1910
The 1911 Census records him as a football trainer lodging with the Topsfield family at 19 Gossett Avenue, Prittlewell, Essex
His only appearance for Brighton was at home against Clapton Orient in the United League on 31.1.1906
At the outbreak of World War 2, he was a corporation worker
Reputedly a good fast bowler in amateur cricket
