LEWIS | John (Jack) Richard

Jottings

Played for Park Mills in the Birmingham Junior League and, in April 1899, played in a representative match for Birmingham Juniors against Scottish Juniors

Played in Burton United's first ever Football League match, but later left the club after a dispute about Summer wages

Was persuaded to rejoin Burton United after only two matches for Kidderminster Harriers and was the club's top scorer that season

Was the first Bristol Rovers player to win a full international cap

Scored a hat trick on his F.A. Cup debut (Bristol Rovers v. Eastleigh on 28.10.1899)

Won a Southern League championship medal with Bristol Rovers in 1904-05

Won a championship medal when Croydon Common were champions of Division 2 of the Southern League in 1908-09

Was Southampton's top scorer in the 1907-08 season, but for some reason only played one match in the club's run to the F.A. Cup semi-final

Held the Croydon Common record for goals in an F.A. Cup match (5 in a 10-1 home win over Farncombe on 19.9.1908)

Held the Croydon Common record for goals in the F.A. Cup in a single season (12 in 1908-09)

Appeared for Croydon Common in 1 minor cup match, without scoring

He appeared in Burton United's first ever match in September 1901 and in its last in April 1910; the only player to do so

After retiring from football, he lived in Burton for the remainder of his life and is buried in Burton Cemetery

Extremely clever and plucky; his lack of stature is a handicap against burly opponents

Small but robust and able to create goal scoring opportunities from seemingly nothing
