Played in a friendly for Crescent United against Charlton Athletic in March 1906 and so impressed the opponents that they persuaded him to join them; Crescent United lost the match 3-1
Played for Charlton Athletic right up to the war
Served in, and played for, the Army from 1917-1919 and was badly wounded on the Western Front
Played for the London F.A. on five occasions in 1911 and 1912
Played for Tunbridge Wells Rangers from 1926 to 1929, making around 90 appearances for the club
Was married to Mary Bramber
Nicknamed "Mosky", he was a cable maker by profession - mainly in Kent
