

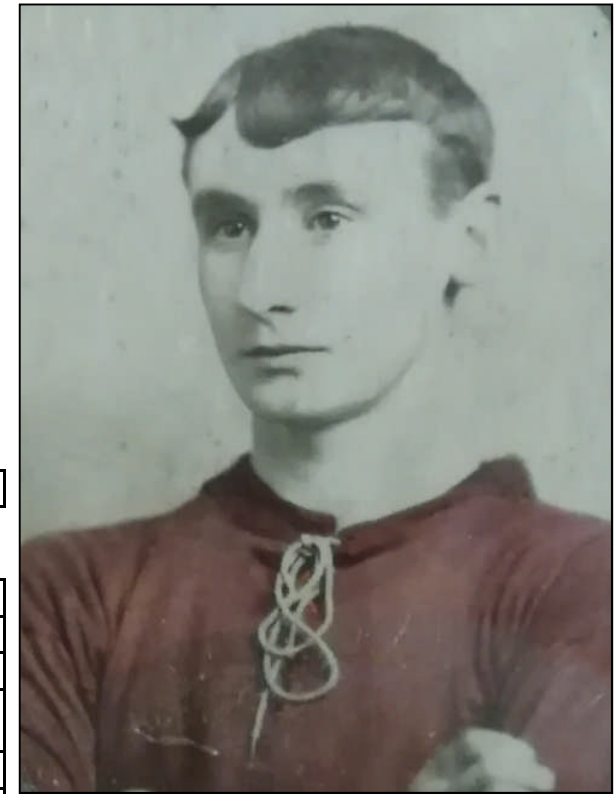

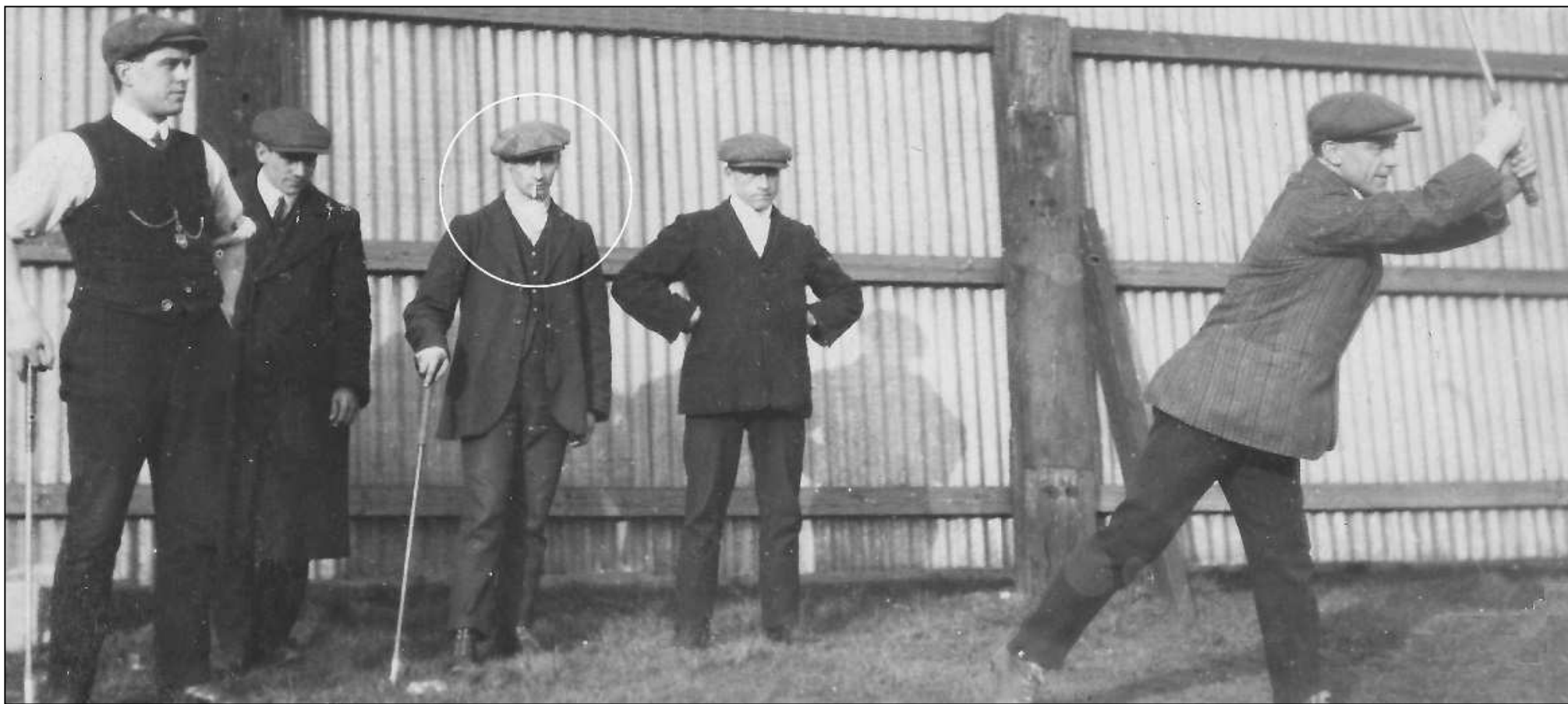

<i>Jottings</i>
He was the fifth of nine children
He was for some reason known to the supporters and the Croydon press as "Micky"
He played one minor cup match for Croydon Common without scoring
The 1911 Census records him as a professional footballer living at 135 Dennett Road, Croydon with his father William (58), a labourer, his mother Emma (57) and his siblings William (28), Gladys (20), Herbert (16) and Victor (13)
Played for Croydon F.C. with Bob Thomson in 1909-10 and then did so again for Croydon Common the following season
It is unclear where he went after he left Croydon Common
He married Kathleen Calden In August 1912 and they later had seven children
His occupation as shown on the marriage certificate was carman, suggesting that he had given up senior football
The 1921 Census records him as a motor body builder at the Wilton Garage in Waddon, Croydon
