Was in the 7th. Battalion Royal Welch Fusiliers prior to joining Aberdare
One of two Cyril Smiths to play for Croydon Common
Served as a private (F/2333) in the Footballers' Battalion
Was gassed at Delville Wood on 28 July 1916 and sent to recover in a hospital in Liverpool
Finished the war as a private in the Royal Army Medical Corps
Played in Charlton Athletic's first professional match (away at Norwich City Reserves on 28.8.1920) and scored in a 2-1 win
Played in 9 reserve matches for Guildford United, scoring 10 goals
In 1924-25, he scored 10 Southern League (Eastern Section), 5 East Midland League and 2 F.A. Cup goals for Nuneaton Town
