Although his second forename is spelt WilfrEd in a Norwich City handbook and in a known signature, birth and census records record it as WilfrId

Had an England schoolboy international trial

No first team appearances at Sunderland

Served in WW1 with the Grenadier Guards and was wounded a few days before the Armistice and was then out of action with pleurisy for seven months

Played the first 18 games of the 1923-24 season for Reading, before being sent off away at Southend United and it took him 18 games to get back in the side

Was manager of Caernarvon Athletic (from 1926) and Rhyl

His Caernarvon Athletic side won the Welsh League in his first season as manager (on £4 per week)

Has the makings of a good player
