<i>Jottings</i>

He was baptised in St. Nicholas Church in Harwich on 9.10.1891
The 1901 census records him as living at 13 East Gate Street, Harwich with his father Frederick (38), a shipwright, his mother Mary Ann (37) and his siblings John (11), Thomas (7), Bessie (4), Charley (1) and Reginald (0)
The 1911 census records him as a general labourer living at 13a East Gate Street, Harwich with his parents and four of his five previously mentioned siblings, plus three new brothers; Harry (7), Alfred (5) and George (3)
In 1910, he joined the 5th. Battalion of the King's Royal Rifle Corps, with the service number 522419, but he may have left shortly afterwards given that the 1911 census records him as a general labourer
When war came, he went to France with the King's Royal Rifle Corps and served as Serjeant 5/3330 in the 1st. Battalion
He was killed on 31 May 1915 and is buried in the Chocques Military Cemetery; his family arranged for his headstone to carry the additional inscription "Duty done never shall thy memory fade"
His elder brother John Frederick TYE was killed on 2.11.1917 while serving as Serjeant 340074 in the 88th Siege Battery of the Royal Garrison Artillery and is buried in Cement House Cemetery in Belgium
Both he and his brother John are remembered on the memorial in the church in which they were baptised; St. Nicholas, Harwich
