A Scot, he played for Dunaskin Lads in Ayrshire and Bolton Wanderers paid the boys' club compensation of £10 for the loss of his services
His two appearances for Bolton Wanderers were a 2-2 draw away at West Bromwich Albion on Saturday 8.2.1913, when he scored twice, and a 0-0 home draw with Everton on Saturday 15.2.1913
Appeared regularly for Bolton Wanderers Reserves in the Central League
Played regularly for Merthyr Town, along with future Robin William Kirby, during the 1913-14 season when the club was relegated from Division One of the Southern League
Played for Merthyr Town during the 1914-15 season after which the club returned to Division One of the Southern League following the War
Was a Private in the Irish Guards when he joined Croydon Common, along with fellow Irish guardsman Sgt. Fox
