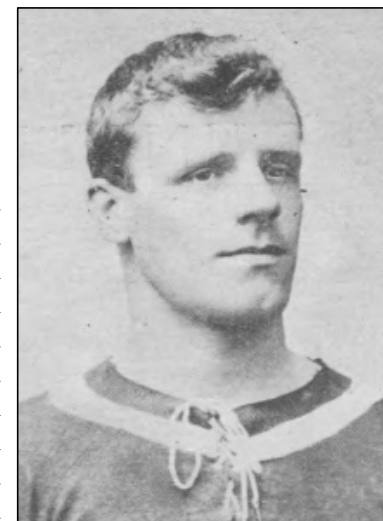

YENSON Philip Owen (William)

Jottings

For some reason he was known as William/Billy at every club

Was apparently of Swedish extraction

Was originally a centre forward and made his F.A. Cup final appearance in this position before becoming a half back

Captained the Queens Park Rangers side which won the Southern League in 1907-08

Gained Southern League Division 2 and Southern Football Alliance championship honours with Croydon Common

Held the Croydon Common record for successive seasons (6 from 1909-10 to 1914-15)

Appeared for Croydon Common in 13 minor cup matches, without scoring

Was the only Croydon Common player to appear on a cigarette or trade card whilst at the club

An injury early in the 1914-15 season ended his Croydon Common career

Appeared 23 times for Margate in 1919-20 in the Kent League, the F.A. Cup and the Kent Senior Cup, scoring once, and he captained the side

His brothers GEORGE and HENRY also played for the Robins and an Act-Sgt G W Yenson of the Royal Field Artillery was awarded the Military Medal in WW1; was it George?

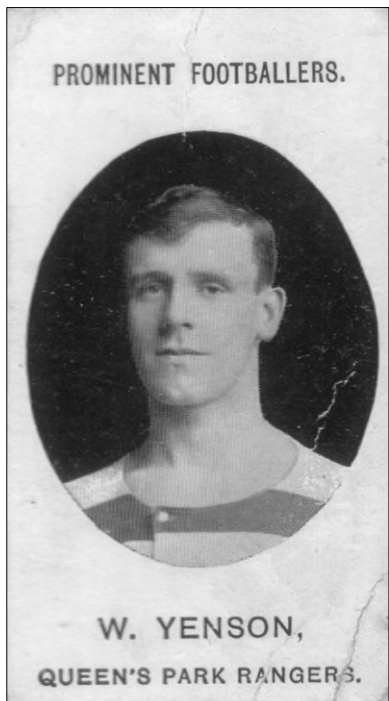
Had a tobacconist's shop at 64 High Street, Thornton Heath in Croydon which he advertised in the Croydon Common handbooks

The 1901 Census records him as Phillip JENSON, a boiler maker's apprentice, living at 209 Beckton Road, West Ham with his father Theodore (53), mother Selina (48) and his siblings Violet (16), George (14), Henry (9) and Gustave (6)

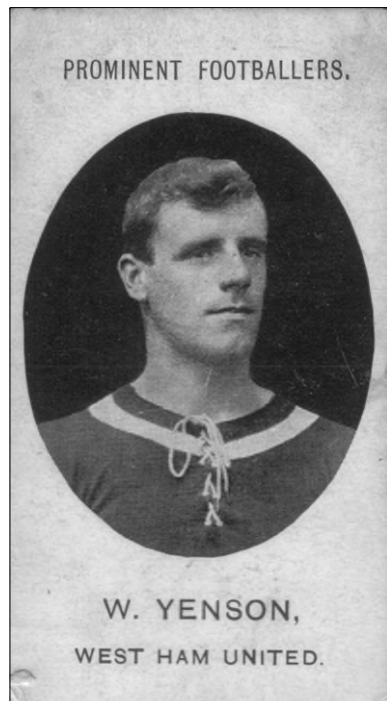
The 1911 census records him as a professional footballer living at 64 High Street, Thornton Heath with his wife Louisa (31) and daughters Dorothy (6), Mabel (4) and Queenie (1)

Died at 144 Elgin Road, Ilford, Essex

His son KENNY played for Bromley against Romford (1-0) in the 1949 Amateur Cup Final at Wembley

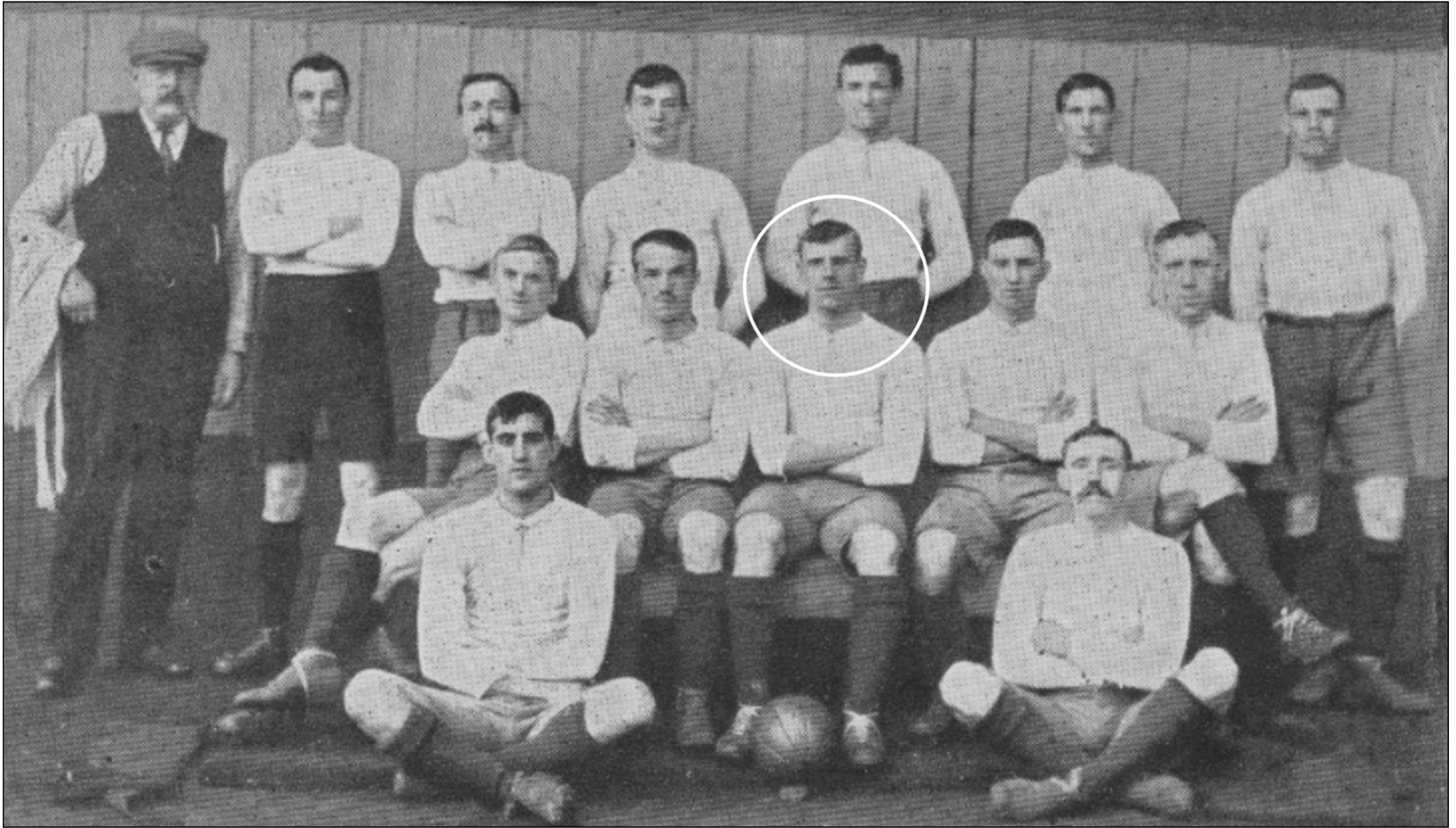

Centre-forward, Philip was a member of the Bolton Wanderers F.A. Cup team in 1904. He then moved south to join Queen's Park Rangers in the Southern League helping them win the Southern League Championship in 1907-08. After a spell with West Ham United he joined Croydon Common where he won a Southern League Second Division title in 1913-14.

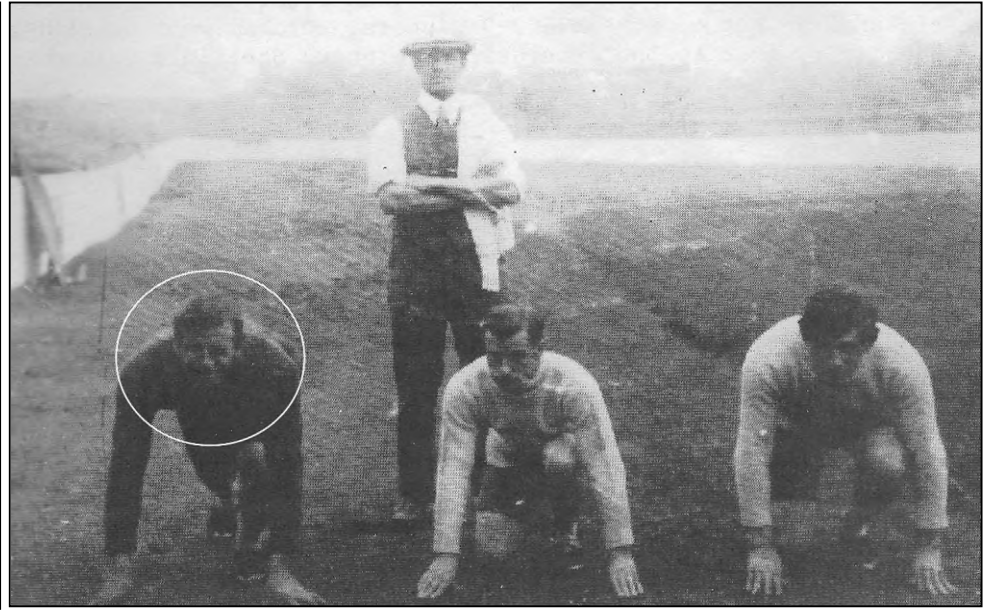
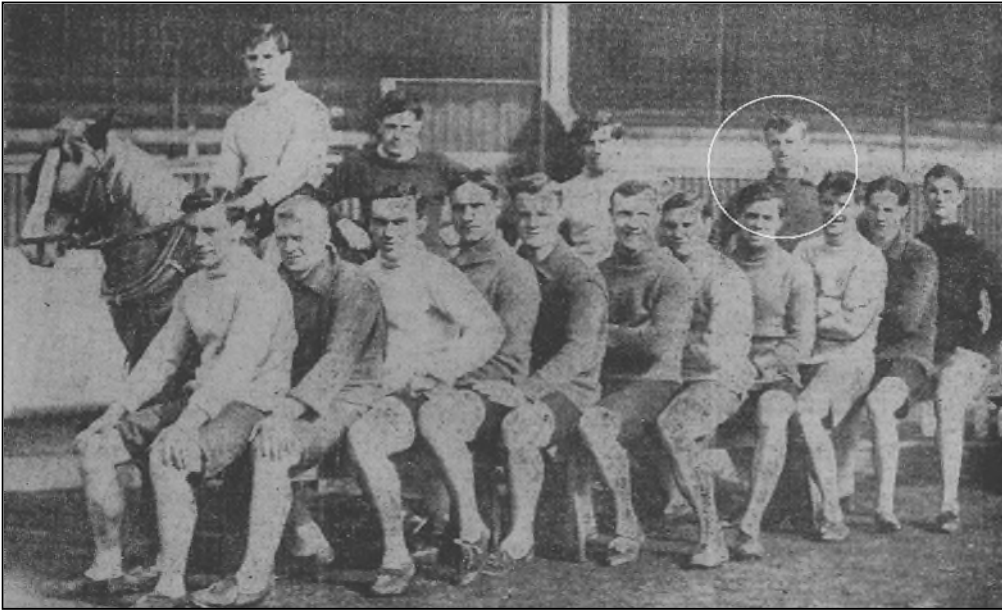
